

How much do you think it costs to keep Bolton Mountain Rescue Team operating?

Each year it costs over £50,000 to keep the team in operation which equates to almost £140 a day. This includes day-to-day costs such as rent and utilities, maintaining key safety and rescue equipment and keeping our specialised vehicles on the road.

But there aren't any mountains in the area...

We hear this a lot. The closest we have is Winter Hill in Bolton – just 150m short of being a mountain – almost there!

However, there are a lot of people out and about in the countryside and we're involved in helping causalities in many different scenarios including:

- Lost or injured walkers, runners or climbers
- Injured mountain bikers
- Supporting the other emergency services in multi-agency search and rescue
- Flood and swift water rescue
- Missing people including children and the elderly



How can you help the team?

We receive no direct government funding and are funded by voluntary donations; this includes charitable grants, bequests, and sponsorships. Every donation no matter its size helps to provide a voluntary, professional service to our local and regional communities, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
